

## About your YukonU student ID card

Our newly designed Yukon University student ID cards will be distributed in the 2021 Winter semester. Whether you are beginning or continuing your studies, the card issued at the start of this semester should be maintained until the end of your studies. At the start of each semester, we'll provide you with a sticker to apply to your card that indicates the current semester and whether you are a full- or part-time student.

The new card also has a barcode which assists with on-campus monitoring during Covid-19. At Ayamdigut Campus, student ID cards must be presented at doors 1 and 5. Please check with your local campus to determine check-in procedures. Visit <u>YukonU.ca/covid-19</u> for the latest Covid-19 response information.

This semester, your student ID card will be sent to you by mail. To order your new card, or replace your existing card, please email connect@yukonu.ca providing:

- Full name
- Yukon University student ID number
- Mailing address
- Digital photo that meets the following photo requirements:
  - Facing forward looking straight towards the camera
  - Eyes open and clearly visible
  - No tint or reflection on your glasses
  - No face or head covering, unless worn for religious or medical reasons
  - Head and shoulders only
  - No filters or digitally enhanced images
  - A white or blank wall background
  - JPEG images only (.jpg or .jpeg file types)
  - File size is limited to 2 megabytes (MB)
