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1. Purpose of Policy

Yukon University is committed to international education as a significant and growing component of the institution. This commitment encompasses:

- a) Recruitment and admission of international students, and the integration of international students in our classes wherever possible
- b) The provision and/or coordination of support services to international students
- c) The possible development of institutional linkages with international partners to assist in the development of student and faculty exchanges
- d) The possible development of partnerships with Universities, institutes and universities in Canada and worldwide to develop joint projects in international education
- e) The exploration of study abroad opportunities for Yukon University students.

3. Procedures

Yukon University International shall

- process international student applications, with the support of the Registrar, and process international student registrations, with the support of the Admissions office
- provide a one-stop information centre for international students regarding study permit renewals, off campus work permit application approvals, medical insurance, accommodation and all other student services
- coordinate agreements including memorandum of understanding, memorandum of agreement, with institutions and agencies outside of Canada and Alaska
- act as the University representative in discussions related to linkage agreements, student, staff and faculty exchange agreements, and
- act as the University representative in discussions related to international projects.
